21-yr-old gangraped by friend, his aide

A 21-year-old married woman alleged she was gangraped by a friend and his accomplice at an under-construction building in Manesar on Monday.

According to the police, the victim belonged to Ghaziabad. She was putting up as a paying guest with a woman in Bhimnagar. "The victim told us that on Monday she received a call from a Noida company, which asked her to come for a job interview. She called up her friend Manish Saini and asked him if he could accompany her to Noida," said Inderjeet, SHO at Sector-18 police station.

In a written statement, the victim claimed instead of taking her to Noida, the two took her to an under-construction building in Manesar where they raped her. Before fleeing, they threatened her of dire consequences in case she reported the incident to anyone.

Somali woman alleges rape bid by driver

A 30-year-old Somali woman has alleged that a taxi driver tried to rape her while she was returning from Agra on November 5. A case in this regard has been registered at the Sunlight Colony police station.

According to southeast district police, the woman and her husband have been residing in the Hauz Rani area near Malviya Nagar in south Delhi for the past several years.

On November 5, the woman had gone to Agra alone. To return back, she boarded a cab that had some other passengers as well. However, all her co-passengers got off at Ballabgarh and Faridabad and she was left alone in the taxi. The woman claimed the driver then tried picking up a conversation with her. As she became friendly, the driver took her to Sarai Kale Khan in southeast Delhi instead of taking her to Malviya Nagar. He parked the vehicle at a desolate spot and tried to rape her, the woman claimed. She said she fought with the driver and managed to push him away. She went to a nearby PCR which then called the police station.

Coastal Thane on high alert

The state has alerted the Thane district collector A L Jarhad, and schools and safe houses have been identified for villagers who will be affected should disaster strike. The cyclonic storm is likely to affect coastal Thane when it will move towards Gujarat. Local tehsildars and the collectorate staff are on high alert. In Maharashtra, the depression in the Arabian Sea

is likely to affect coastal Thane, mainly Dahanu. Mumbai, Thane and other parts of the Konkan will have heavy rainfall.

Coast Guard Inspector-General (West) S P S Basra said that all ships, aircrafts and helicopters are in a state of preparedness in case of an emergency, and are ready for any eventuality.

Nigerian credit card scam: Cops nab accused in Jaipur

The Powai police on Monday arrested a 30-year-old man in Jaipur who was a member of a gang involved in the Nigerian credit card scam. The gang had duped several persons across India of over Rs 200 crore in the last four years.

According to investigators, one of the accomplices, Raju alias Rajesh Muja, was a driver by profession but his bank account showed transactions worth crores of rupees, done in the last few months. Rajesh was caught based on the information provided by the five accused who were caught for cheque forgery and credit card fraud in October by the Powai police. He is one of the accused and withdrew Rs 9.9 lakh from businessman Rahul Jashnani's bank account.

The fraud came to light when Jashnani who resides at Hiranandani Gardens in Powai found out about the fraudulent transaction when he checked the online status of his account. The transaction was done using forged signatures on stolen cheques that were last month deposited in one Jivraj's account in another bank.

Cyclone to unleash heavy rain over State

A cyclone developing over the Arabian Sea is likely to intensify in the next 48 hours bringing heavy rain to coastal Karnataka, according to the Meteorological Department here.

Bangalore and other parts of interior Karnataka will also come within the cyclone's reach, said B. Putanna, an official with the Met Department. Cloudy skies and rainfall will continue for the next two days at least.

The IMD's cyclone alert for the south Gujarat and north Maharashtra coast sounds a warning for coastal Karnataka, which, it says, will see "heavy to very heavy" rainfall along with squally winds with speeds "reaching 55 to 65 kmph and gusting to 75 kmph".

The sea will be very rough along the Karnataka coast.

Viral infections on the rise in city

The rain and sudden drop in temperature in the city have brought a slew of infections with it. Hospitals in the city are recording a rise in the number of people suffering from various viral infections including gastro-enteritis, malaria and typhoid. This is apart from bronchial asthma, lung and upper respiratory tract infections and leptospirosis.

Most people affected by these infections have common symptoms such as diarrhoea, vomiting and dehydration, running nose, body pain, headache, sore throat, fever for three or four days, cough and, in some cases, wheezing.

Director of BPO unit held for data theft

The Kothrud police arrested the director of a business process outsourcing (BPO) unit for his alleged involvement in stealing medical history data of a UK-based company and selling it to another company. The police also booked two suspects in this regard.

Vikas Dhairyashil Bansode (29) of Uttamnagar was arrested after a complaint was lodged by the zonal officer of NASSCOM, Paresh Vinayak Degaonkar (37), with the cyber cell of Pune crime branch. The other two suspects have been identified as Kunal Abhay Gargatti of Belgam and Jayesh Bhagchandani. All the three have been booked under several sections of the Information Technology Act.

Goods worth Rs 1.87 lakh looted from three shops

Unidentified suspects broke into three shops located at Anand complex on Paud road and fled with goods worth Rs 1.87 lakh during the wee hours of Monday. A complaint in this regard has been lodged by Popat Magdum (40) of Mahatma society, Kothrud, with the Kothrud police station.

According to the police, Magdum owns a spare parts shop, Anup Motors. During the wee hours of Monday, the suspects broke the shutter of the shop and decamped with cash and spare parts worth Rs 97,775. The suspects also broke-into three other shops in the shopping complex. They fled with laptops and Rs 8,000 in cash from Rajendra Nilegaonkar's shop and Rs 25,000 in cash from labour supplier office owned by Somnath Wagh.

This is second such incident in the last two days where suspects have managed to break into shops. During the early hours of Sunday, the suspects broke into seven shops in Vishal Residency in Kasarwadi and fled with cell phones and recharge vouchers totalling to Rs 2 lakh.

Special train to Delhi till Jan 1

The railways has decided to extend the superfast special trains running between Pune and Hazrat Nizamuddin up to January 2010 to clear the extra rush of passengers.

Train No 0477 Pune-Hazrat Nizamuddin special train will run on every Friday from November 13 to January 1, 2010. The train will depart from Pune at 2.10 pm and will reach Hazrat Nizamuddin at 4.40 pm next day.

On return trip, No 0478 Hazrat Nizamuddin-Pune train will run every Thursday from November 12 to December 31. The train will depart from Hazrat Nizamuddin at 8.55 am and will reach Pune at 11.05 am next day.

The reservation for the train has been made available from November 11. The train will have one coach each of I A/C, II A/C, III A/C and eight second class coaches, besides four unreserved general compartments.

Lashkar commander killed

Two dreaded militants of the Lashkar-e-Toiba (LeT) outfit were eliminated by security forces in the Mahore area of Reasi district this evening. One of the killed militant was self-styled district commander of the LeT.

According to reports, a joint operation was launched by the Rashtriya Rifles (RR) and the police in the Sharjroo area, about 15 km from Mahore town. During the search operation, the security personnel entered into an encounter with militants, who were hiding in the forest.

In an hour-long gunfight, the security forces eliminated two militants. The slain militants has been identified as Mohammad Rafiq, alias Noman of Chitta Bagh, Mahore, and Zabbar Ahmed of Mahore.

Suicide car bomb kills 30 in Pakistan market

A suicide car bomb tore through a crowded shopping street in Pakistan on Tuesday, killing 30 people in the third militant attack to strike the nuclear-armed country in as many days.

The bomber blew up his vehicle in the heart of the northwest town of Charsadda on a road lined with fruit and juice shops, ripping off shop roofs and littering the ground with slippers, human flesh and broken push carts.

The United States has put Pakistan on the frontline of its war against al-Qaida and has been increasingly disturbed by deteriorating security in the country where attacks and bombings have killed about 2,500 people in 28 months.
