### City's own German Bakery and Chabad House given security cover

High on terror radar, Delhi's own German Bakery can easily pass off as just another building in the bustling bylanes of Paharganj until you notice a stream of visitors, mostly foreigners.

The capital's Chabad House, lost in a quiet corner of the locality, also diffuses in the concrete jungle. But after the Pune attack, both the destinations, popular among foreign tourists, easily stand out, for the heavy security ring around them.

### Two British nationals detained with suspicious gadgets

Two British nationals staying at the Radisson Hotel near the Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA) here have been detained and are being questioned for being in the possession of suspicious gadgets, police said.

Stephen Hampston and Steven Martin were detained by the Intelligence Bureau (IB) and Delhi Police on Monday for possessing some high-tech gadgets, maps and binoculars.

Delhi has been on high alert since Saturday after a blast in Pune that left nine people dead and several injured.

### Two men held for snatching in Ghaziabad

Two men on a motorcycle were caught red handed while they were snatching a woman's purse and mobile phone here on Tuesday.

The two men, identified as Amir and Salman, snatched the purse and mobile phone of Shalini Tyagi, who was going to her office in a cyclerickshaw, in the Raj Nagar District Centre area, Superintendent of Police AK Vijeta said. As Tyagi raised an alarm, passersby caught hold of the two men and handed them over to a patrolling police vehicle which had reached the spot. Amir is a resident of Maujpur in Delhi, while Salman stays at Brahmpuri in Jafrabad, also in Delhi.

The two confessed to having snatched 30 mobiles, 10 gold chains and several purses from various locations in Delhi.

### Hunt for safe haven takes guerrillas to Birbhum

They have unleashed a reign of terror in the three districts of Jangalmahal. Now, the Maoists are making their presence felt in Birbhum as well, and it's no longer a case of isolated incidents but of a well-planned ploy to bring new territories under their influence.

The Red base has reportedly spread to extensive areas under three police stations Khayrasole, Rajnagar and Dubrajpur in the district. There are around 25 gram panchayats in these three areas comprising 350-odd villages. Observers say the Maoists are moving into Birbhum probably because they want to divert the attention of forces during Operation Green Hunt and also because they want to set up new hideouts.

### Gang held, jewellery recovered

#### Prohibitory orders in place

The city police have prohibited holding of public meetings, processions and carrying of arms like swords, sticks with or without flags, guns, explosives and other weapons in the State capital.

The orders would be in force from 6 a.m. on February 16 to 6 a.m. on February 22. The assembly of persons on roads and public places and carrying of stones was also banned.

Use of mikes and public address systems by different organisations near the Secretariat and its surrounding areas, and the flyover leading to Visveswarayya statue, Khairatabad, was also prohibited.

Penal action would be initiated against persons violating these directions. However, the prohibitory orders would not be applicable to police and military personnel, home guards on duty and funeral processions.

#### New jihadist group claims responsibility for Pune attack

Even as Maharashtra police investigators said little progress was made in identifying the perpetrators of Saturday's bombing of the German Bakery in Pune, an unknown Pakistan-based jihadist group has claimed responsibility for the attack that claimed 10 lives.

Identifying himself as a spokesperson of a group calling itself the Lashkar-e-Taiba al-Almi, an individual using the code-name 'Abu Jindal' said the bombing was carried out because of India's "refusal" to discuss the Kashmir issue in the coming talks with Pakistan.

#### **Al-Qaida unit warns sportspersons against visiting India**

Vowing to carry out attacks across India, Pakistan-occupied Kashmir-based terror group HuJI has warned international sportspersons against visiting the country to participate in upcoming events like the Hockey World Cup, IPL and Commonwealth Games.

Asia Times Online claimed Ilyas Kashmiri, a former Pakistani commando whose 313 Brigade is an operational arm of al-Qaida, has vowed to continue attacks across India while threatening international sportspersons to face the consequences if they chose to visit the country.

Kashmiri is believed to have directed LeT operative David Coleman Headley in his planning missions for the Mumbai terror attacks in 2008.

Missiles fired from a US drone killed four militants at a compound in northwest Pakistan's lawless tribal region Wednesday.
