### **Bangalore man offers rooftops on rent, dupes many**

An unidentified conman duped several landowners across the country by placing ads in local newspapers, offering to rent rooftops to install mobile towers for Rs 40,000 per month.

Victims were encouraged to invest in the towers, initially paying anywhere between Rs 50,000 to Rs 4 lakh, with long-term investments yielding about Rs 40 lakh over a period of 15 years.

The company was called Khan Gold K, and even had a website to make the operation seem more legitimate. The building watchman, Mallappa said, "The office has been empty for 20 days now."

### **Robbers target Chennai-Hyderabad Express**

The spate of train robberies on the Guntur-Nadikudi railway line continued when unidentified miscreants targeted the Chennai-Hyderabad Express (2603) in the early hours of Thursday and snatched ornaments from passengers sleeping on berths near the windows. The incident took place at 2.30 a.m., minutes after the train crossed Nadikudi railway station.

This is the third such incident reported in the last two weeks. Two women passengers travelling in Secunderabad-bound Narayanadri Express were relieved of ornaments in the wee hours of last Friday.

### **Security beefed up on trains**

The South Central Railway has beefed up security in trains due to chain-snatching incidents. The security was increased following a chain snatching incident on the Chennai-Hyderabad Express. Following such incidents, the Government Railway Police, a wing of the State

government and the Railway Protection Force of South Central Railway have decided to cover all the night trains with armed escorts. Joint combing operations were also ordered at en-route stations to prevent entry of unsocial elements.

### **Five killed, 35 injured in four road mishaps**

Five persons were killed and 35 others injured in four separate road accidents in various parts of the state on Thursday. Police are investigating into the incidents.

According to reports, a speeding minibus turned turtle near Madhav Nagar in Mandalgarh area killing two persons on the spot. Another person, who was admitted to a nearby hospital, succumbed to his injuries.

In other incident, two persons were killed and two others sustained injuries when a van, in which they were travelling, collided with a truck near Ajmer road. The vehicle was badly damaged and the bodies were stuck in the van. A witness claimed the van driver was driving rashly and he rammed his vehicle into the truck.

#### **Rajouri Kadal — the new protest zone**

Almost every Friday the Rajouri Kadal area, in the heart of the old city of Srinagar, becomes the centre of activity between stone throwing youths and security personnel, resulting in injuries to several persons.

And recently the area hit the headlines due to the death of a teenage boy, Tufail Ahmad Mattoo, on Friday last. This is the second incident in which a youth was killed due to a tear-gas shell fired by the police to quell stone-throwing youths and that too in the open space of the Gani Memorial Stadium of the State Sport Council.

During the past few years frequent clashes had taken place in the Rajouri Kadal area, earlier more frequent in Nowhatta, on the other side of the Jamia Masjid. This apparently is because of the shifting of the security forces camp from the Nowhatta area.

**191 killed in Kyrgyzstan violence since last week**

At least 191 people have been killed and thousands injured in the ethnic clashes in southern Kyrgyzstan since last week, Kyrgyz health ministry said Thursday.

As of Thursday morning, the number of people killed in clashes in the south of the republic has risen to 191. A total of 1,971 people have also sought medical aid, and 957 of them have been hospitalized.

**46 dead in landslides in Myanmar**

At least 46 people have died in landslides triggered by heavy rain in western Myanmar near the border with Bangladesh, state media reported on Thursday.

Bridges, homes and other buildings were damaged after record rainfall of more than 13 inches (33 centimetres) on Wednesday in parts of Rakhine State, the New Light of Myanmar newspaper said.

Dozens of people have also been killed across the border in southeastern Bangladesh where heavy rain has triggered flash floods and landslides in recent days, according to police there.
