Doctors strike for lack of food

Around eighty resident doctors of civic-run Bhabha Hospital in Bandra went on strike the entire day on Monday, leaving the workload of patients on senior doctors, interns and other staff.

The problem, said the resident doctors, was that, all were not getting any food on the hospital premises as their canteen was forcefully shut down by the workers' union of the hospital after a personal tiff between a union member and canteen staff.

According to resident doctor Aditya Menon, the problem had started on last Tuesday. "There was an argument between the canteen staff and a union worker on Monday night. A union worker was injured in the brawl. The next day, the hospital union came to the canteen and forced it shut," he said, adding that the canteen was closed since then.

Traffic restrictions for PM's visit

Traffic restrictions have been imposed in connection with the Prime Minister Manmohan Singh's visit to the city on Tuesday.

Traffic will be stopped or diverted between 11 am to 12 noon and 3 pm to 4 pm in the road stretch from Begumpet airport, PNT junction, Shyamlal building, Hyderabad Public School (HPS), Begumpet flyover, Greenlands junction, Punjagutta flyover, Punjagutta graveyard, Srinagar T junction, Green mosque, KBR Park, Jubilee Hills check post, Road number 36 and Madhapur police station.

Similarly, traffic restrictions on the movement of heavy goods vehicles, tippers and tractors have been imposed between Cyber Towers to Kothaguda junction, Gachibowli junction to ISB junction, ISB junction to Wipro junction, Wipro junction to Gowlidoddi village and Gowlidoddi village to Gopanpally thanda from 11.25 am to 3.55 pm.

French protests intensify, government stands firm

French truck drivers staged go-slow operations on highways, rail strikes intensified and petrol stations ran out of fuel on Monday as protests gathered pace ahead of a Senate vote on an unpopular pension overhaul.

The government, which has stood firm on President Nicolas Sarkozy's plan to raise the retirement age through months of protests, assured the public infrastructure would not freeze up despite a week-long strike at refineries that dried up supplies at hundreds of the roughly 12,500 petrol stations nationwide.

"The situation is critical," a spokeswoman at Exxon Mobil said. "Anyone looking for diesel in the Paris and Nantes (Western France) regions will have problems," she said.

Strike action was ramping up ahead of a nationwide march on Tuesday and with a final Senate vote on the pension bill set for Wednesday it was looking like a make-or-break week for Sarkozy.

Workers at France's 12 refineries were in their seventh day of a strike on Monday and protesters were blocking access many fuel distribution depots around the country.
