Terror Threat: Police keeps tight vigil

The Delhi police today said it is on constant vigil to prevent any terrorist strike in the capital and all security measures have been adopted in this regard.

Delhi police was put on alert after the US embassy followed by other foreign missions yesterday warned of possible terror attacks in crowded markets in the Indian capital. The alert has been sounded after the US information that terrorists were planning to target foreigners, particularly Americans, in some Indian cities. Interpreting the message as warning of terrorist attack in markets like Chandni Chowk, Connaught Place, Greater Kailash, Karol Bagh, Mehrauli, and Sarojini Nagar, police in these markets yesterday was remain under the watchful eyes of khakhi clad personnel.

However, no untoward incident was reported from any markets.

Couple held for duping, snatching jewels from the public

The police on Thursday arrested a 28-year-old man and his girlfriend who, working as a couple, were allegedly involved in several chain-snatching incidents in the city. Nine cases were solved and about 44 sovereigns of gold jewellery recovered, the police said. The two, the police said, would go cruising on a two-wheeler and approach people walking on roads under the pretext of seeking an address before snatching their jewels.

During a vehicle-check near Kotturpuram, a team led by crime wing inspector K Chellappa

picked up for questioning a couple on a two-wheeler who didn't reply properly to the police's questions. They were grilled separately and out came the story.

The police recovered 44 sovereigns of gold jewellery that they had pledged with various pawnbrokers in the suburbs.

Surge in diarrhoea cases in city

The city is witnessing a surge in acute diarrhoeal disease (ADD) cases over the past two weeks with as many as 437 reported ADD cases in Hyderabad alone, according to epidemic wing of the directorate of health.

Medical records during the current year indicate a significant rise in ADD cases compared to that of 2009 when 316 cases were reported as on date. These cases stand testimony to the unsafe drinking water supplied by the water board.

All the 21 jaundice cases reported till date in the state are from Hyderabad. Of these, three cases were reported last week. Of the 11 cases of jaundice, which were reported last year, not a single case was from the rest of the districts. Besides, all the five cholera cases reported in the state are from Hyderabad and Ranga Reddy districts.

Hunt on for two Pak militants

Four days after they escaped, two heavily armed Pakistan terrorists continue to elude the security forces in the Rajbagh area. The Kathua police, along with the Special Operations Group (SOG), Territorial Army and the CRPF, was on the job.

The militants, after successfully intruding into the state, had fired upon a police party on April 19 before taking refuge in a forest nursery near Chabechak village.

The security forces had found a rucksack from the nursery containing wire cutters, some eatables and documents the next morning.

48 pro-Taliban militants killed in Pakistan

Forty-eight pro-Taliban militants and two security personnel were killed in clashes across the restive Orakzai tribal region of northwest Pakistan on Thursday.

Twenty-five militants and four security personnel were also injured in the clashes that occurred at three places.

Three injured militants were captured by the security forces. The clashes erupted when militants tried to halt advancing forces in the Taliban strongholds of Sanghra, Qambar Masi and Mashti Mela in Orakzai Agency.

Fifteen militants were killed when security forces targeted militant hideouts in Mashti Mela.
